



# How to upload a video to YouTube from your Phone

1. If you haven't already done so, download the YouTube app and sign in. You will need to supply your email address. If you are younger than 13, please use an account belonging to an adult.
2. Open the YouTube app
3. Click on the video icon at the top right-hand side of the window, which can be found next to your user icon, messages, apps, and notifications.
4. At this point, you will have two choices. 1. Record; 2. Go Live and; 3. Thumbnail versions of your pre-recorded videos from your camera roll. I recommend that you pre-record your video using your phone camera.
5. After identifying which video you plan to upload, touch the thumbnail of that recording. A screen will appear with the option to trim the video or upload by pressing "NEXT" in the upper right-hand corner of the screen.
6. You will now see a window which allows you to set the title, description, and privacy settings.
7. Type your name in the TITLE box. In the DESCRIPTION box, please indicate which orchestra you plan to audition for (Strings, Sinfonietta, Philharmonic or Symphony). If you will be uploading multiple videos, please indicate that intention by saying like, "First of two videos."
8. Choose the privacy settings on your video to "Unlisted." This keeps your video private (people can't search and discover your video) but allows the SYS staff to view your recording once you share the address. Then click the "UPLOAD" button. Wait a long time! If you don't see your video listed, even though you've uploaded it, click on your library icon. This will refresh the page and you will see the thumbnail.
9. Share your video with the SYS staff by clicking the share icon.
